

## RECOMMENDED KĪPAHULU RULES

### BAG LIMITS:

- Finfish: 10 per day (except for akule, roi, ta'ape, to'au)
- Moano: 2 per day
- Ulua/pāpio: 1 per day
- 'Opihi: 1 gallon per day

### SEASONS:

- Kūmū, moano, uhu, moi: Closed season June-September

### SPECIES GEAR RESTRICTIONS:

- Akule: Minimum 2 3/4" mesh for nets, no spotter planes
- Moi: No take using surround net fishing method

### GENERAL GEAR RESTRICTIONS:

- Thrownet: Minimum mesh size 2 3/4"
- Hook-and-line: Max 2 lines deployed at a time
- SCUBA/underwater breathing apparatus: No take/possession of marine life while using gear

### OTHER:

- Akule: Take for non-commercial purposes only
- 'Opihi: No take within a rest area

## NEW STATE RULES

(as of 11/1/14)

### BAG LIMIT:

- Kūmū: 1 per day
- Moano kea: 2 per day
- Munu: 2 per day
- Uhu: 2 per day
- Oama (less than 5"): 50 per day (pole and line only)
- No take of blue male fish (uhu 'uli 'uli, uhu 'ele'ele)

### SIZE LIMIT:

- Large goatfish: 12" minimum
- Small goatfish: 8" minimum
- Large uhu: 14" minimum
- Small uhu: 10" minimum

## OTHER STATE RULES THAT APPLY

### SEASON:

- Kūmū, moano, uhu: No closed season
- Moi: Closed season June-August

### GENERAL GEAR RESTRICTIONS:

- Thrownet: Minimum mesh size 2"
